

California CTE Model Curriculum Standards – the "WHAT"

The nationally recognized California CTE Model Curriculum Standards incorporate academic and workplace skills into the middle and high school curriculum for each of the 15 industry sectors. The standards include 11 foundation standards that students need to master to succeed at CTE and work

California CTE Model Curriculum Standards – the "WHAT"

These standards are now infused with the academic rigor required to prepare students for post-secondary education and training.

- 2. Communications
- 3. Career Planning and Management
- 4. Technology
- 5. Problem Solving and Critical Thinking
- 6. Health and Safety
- 7. Responsibility and Flexibility
- 8. Ethics and Legal Responsibilities

- 10. Technical Knowledge and Skills
- 11. Demonstration and Application

Pathway Standards

- 1. Specific to individual Career areas
- 2. Specified in CTE Standards document
